1. HC Video- reviewed rough draft
 - Discussed labeling
 - Should we include diagnostic labels? → include physical/medical diagnoses also?
 - Include introductions at the end and have audience check their assumptions?
 - Conclusion was to have the person say their own diagnosis rather than us labeling them
 - Include screenshot discussing purpose – Ex. “This is intended for... This was created for use by...”
 - Purpose → “Reflection on beliefs and behaviors of healthcare providers that either support or become barriers to recovery”
 - Audience is healthcare providers
 - For use by health care coordinators
 - INCLUDE
 - Intro piece (“reflection on...”)
 - First name & relationship (where appropriate)
 - Include interview footage of Mackenzie
 - Be prepared with handout resource on Certified Peer Specialists
 - Length – 10 minutes is good, don’t make any longer

2. Healthcare training/compassion fatigue modules: (postponed for next meeting since Liz and Stefanie could not join us.)
